THE MICHAEL G. HADFIELD ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FOR PACIFIC ISLANDS STUDENTS

The University of Hawai'i is pleased to announce a scholarship opportunity to support undergraduate students who are permanent residents of the Federated States of Micronesia, Republic of Palau, Republic of the Marshall Islands, American Samoa, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and Guam, and who are or will be pursuing undergraduate degrees in life sciences (e.g. biology, microbiology, marine biology, botany, natural resources and ecological management, global environmental sciences) at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and/or Kapi'olani Community College campuses.

ELIGIBILITY:

Students who are permanent residents of the Federated States of Micronesia, Republic of Palau, Republic of the Marshall Islands, American Samoa, Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands and Guam.

Must be enrolled full-time pursuing undergraduate degrees in life sciences (e.g. biology, microbiology, marine biology, botany, natural resources and ecological management, global environmental sciences) at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa and/or Kapi'olani Community College campuses.

Students transferring from Kapi'olani Community College to the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa shall also be considered.

Cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above.

Financial need shall be a criterion in making this award although not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines.
